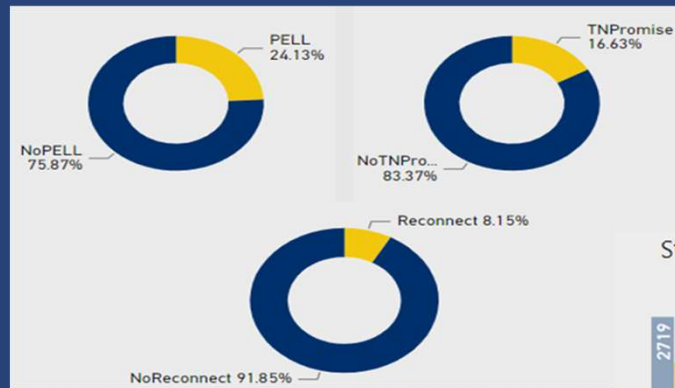

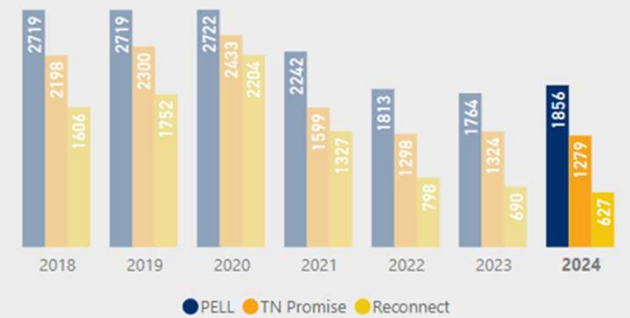

Student Receiving PELL, TN Promise, and Reconnect

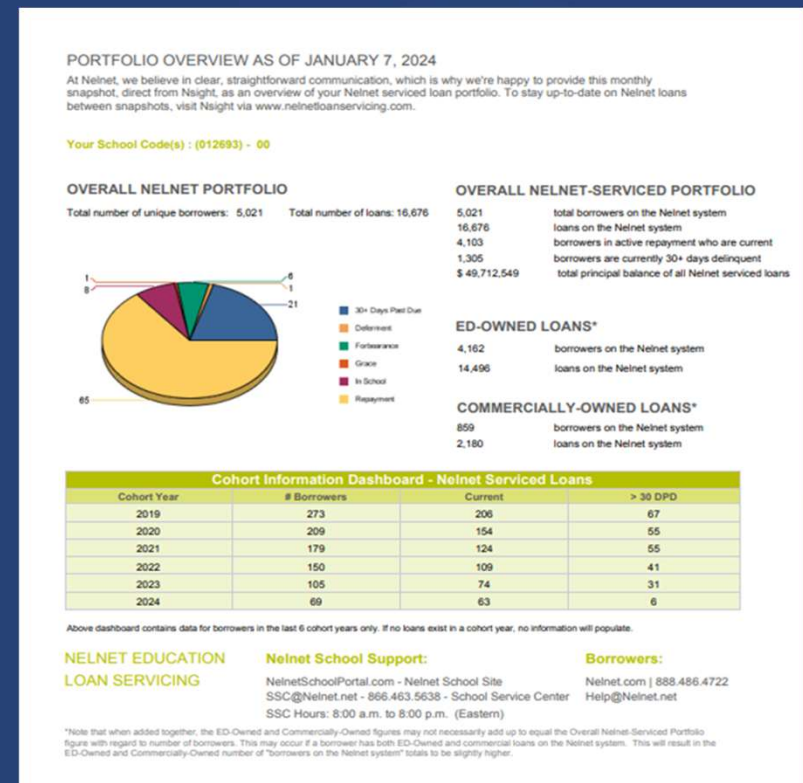
