
Surveys are a quick way to identify trends, questions, and concerns.

## Background


Goal: Offer education and assistance to campus partners, and inform internal teams of ongoing trends.

- Must be currently enrolled in a 4-year non-profit college or university




## "Have you considered putting your college education on hold or leaving college?"

#### **Impact of Financial Aid Offices**




Frequency of visits


When students visit at least once per month...

- The higher perceived helpfulness of FAOs


## **Students' Awareness of Services Provided**



## **Helpfulness Perception**




### **Communication Frequency**

#### **Communication Method**


How would you prefer to communicate with your college's financial aid office?



Method of communication


## **Communication - What They are Asking For**

What have you connected with your college's financial aid office about?




% of responses






#### Student behaviors

What resources do you use to learn about college finances?




#### What do you use those resources for?
